

The series will chart British Fatherhood over the last 100 years. The first programme in the series will concentrate on men that became fathers between 1900 and 1939. It would be

wonderful to record the thoughts and feelings of men now in their 80's, 90's and 100's reflecting on their role as fathers.

As the series will look at Fatherhood throughout the decades we are also interested in speaking to any other lively characters amongst your members that might be willing to share their experiences. I'm particularly interested in how men in the police force balanced their responsibility to the community with their responsibilities to their family.
