

### **On-Call Federated Ranks - Payment per Session**

As of the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 police officers, of Federated Ranks, who volunteer for 'On Call' are paid £15 per session (24 hours).

The Winsor 2 Review into Police Officer Terms and Conditions recommended that payment for police officers undertaking voluntary 'On Call' duties should be brought formally into Police Regulations. A payment of £15 per session (24hours) was proposed.

Following the completion of the negotiation process, in January 2013, the Home Secretary ratified the decision of the Police Arbitration Tribunal to pay £15 per session (24 hours) of 'On Call' and for this to commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013.

The Sussex Police Federation made representation to the Force at the Joint Consultation Forum in December 2012, that in order to resolve some on-going issues with 'On Call', the Force bring forward the implementation of the £15 payment to January 2013.

The proposal was considered and as a gesture of goodwill it has been agreed that all claims from Federated Rank Sussex Officers who perform 'On Call' (with the exception of Fire Arms Tactical Advisors) will be paid £15 per session (24hours) from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013.
